Lauchlan Daniel (L.D.) Fleming, 91, recently of Cochrane, passed away October 12, 2018. He was predeceased by his beloved wife Elaine and son Rannoch.

Lauchie was a man of the sea who spent his adult life on the prairies. He was a great painter but a poet first and foremost. Fifty years ago Lauchie and Elaine took up painting and never stopped.

They outfitted vans for cross-country travel and painting. Lauchie and Elaine were founding members of the Canmore Artists and Artisans Guild, and were Life Members of the Calgary Sketch Club, where a Lifetime Achievement Award given out yearly has been named after them. Lauchie was a founding member of the Ice Carving Competitions in Canmore and was an essential member of the volunteer Arts Events of the 1988 Calgary Olympics. In 1987 Lauchie started The Corner Gallery in Canmore where he promoted so many artists, and was immensely humble about his own work. Rannoch gradually took over the gallery and it was present in the Canmore arts scene until 2010. Lauchie and Elaine were also members of the Bragg Creek Painters, until it's closing this spring.



We are all deeply happy that he will now be reunited with the love of his life, Elaine. Lauchie, Dad, Grandpa, will be so missed. His ability to reach out to others and to reflect on life are inspirations to us all. A Celebration of Life was Held Sunday October 28, 2018.
